8. **Brief Summary of Activity** :
  - a. **Objectives:** The aim of this activity is to understand the mangrove clean-up importance and the biodiversity which gets affected due to it. 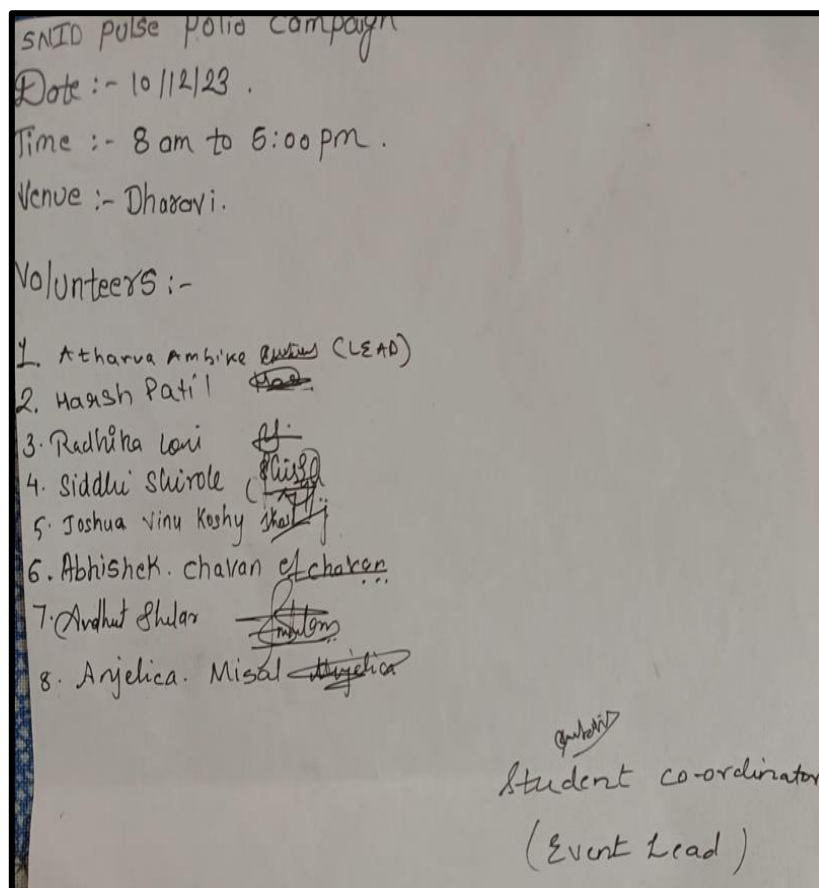


**9. Brief Summary of Activity:**

- a. **Objectives:** To spread awareness about Polio among the society and vaccinate the young population of age five and less than five years over the region where there is high chance of people getting affected with polio. The campaign was held by the BMC and the NSS volunteers were there to help and support medical staff.



- b. **Description:** Eight members of the FCRIT NSS Unit gathered at Pila Bungalow health post 2, Shatabdinagar, Dharavi, Sion 400017 and coordinated with Medical Experts create awareness about polio and vaccinate young generation with locals of Dharavi and Medical Experts, which was organized by BMC (Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation).
- c. **Outcomes:** A total of 1825 children were vaccinated during the campaign. The campaign was successful in achieving its objectives of promoting polio vaccination and raising awareness about the importance about Polio dose.

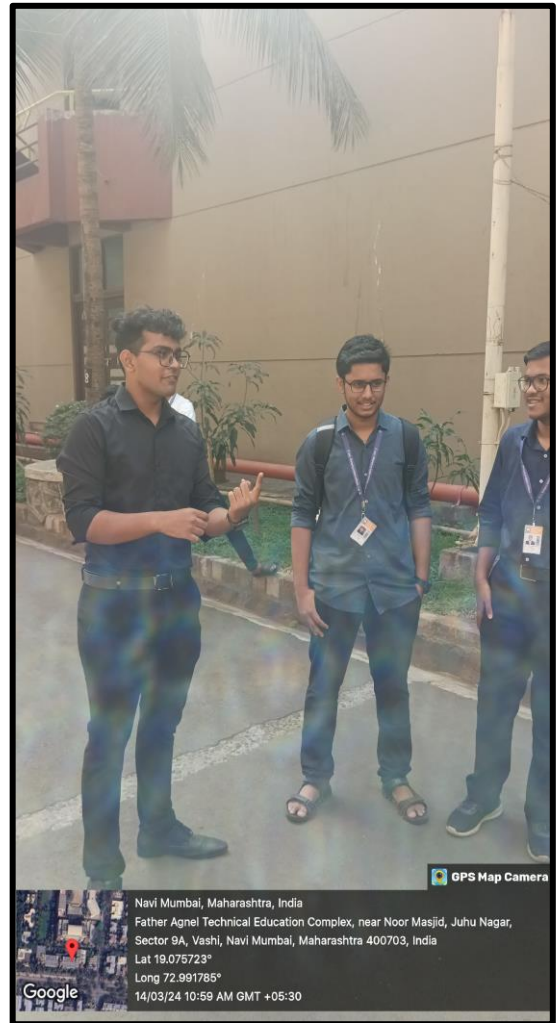
